**2. NEW BUSINESS.**

Public Works Director Steve Hardt reported that bid documents will be sent out next week for the Canyon Road and North Hickory Street Projects.

3. **ADMINISTRATION.**

A. **Discuss Waste Water Treatment Plant expansion.**

Public Works Director Steve Hardt reported the final design plans for the Waste Water Treatment Plant expansion have been sent to Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality. When the plans are returned to the city from the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality, bids will be advertised.

B. **Discuss traffic and parking signage.**

Chairman Lou Martin spoke about the city replacing old and unnecessary traffic and parking signage. He also discussed the realignment of stop signs to create major thoroughfare streets.
