3. MINUTES.

A. Motion was made by Councilor John Anderson, to approve the minutes of the June 19, 2017, regular City Council meeting.

Motion was made by Vice-Mayor Louis Martin, seconded by Councilor Alan Jones, to approve the following consent items:

- **B.** Approve the sewer easement agreement with Praise Center Ministries, Inc., for property located at 5672 Highway 117, Sapulpa, Oklahoma;
- **C.** Approve the renewal of an agreement with Ms. Wendy Campbell in the amount of \$8,280.00 for services associated with the Park Department's Maintenance Management and Cost Tracking Program;
- **D.** Approve the agreement with Ms. Mary Hinsch for lake caretaker services for FY 2017-2018;
- **E.** Approve the agreement with Ms. Brean Crosby-Fowler for webmaster services associated with the Sapulpa Parks' sapulpaparks.org website in the amount of \$2,425.00 per year for FY 2017-2018;

- **B.** Approve the agreement with Alliance Maintenance for janitorial services at the Senior Citizens Community Center in the amount of \$695.00 per month for a one year term;

- **C.** Approve the agreement with Titan Commercial Services for janitorial services at five (5) park restroom buildings in the amount of \$750.00 per month for a one year term.

Motion was made by Councilor John Anderson, seconded by Vice-Mayor Louis Martin, to approve the close-out of the Bird Avenue Improvement Project (North Main Street to Highway 97) with H & H Frame, Inc., and final pay request in the amount of \$43,113.57, which includes all retainage withheld; approve all other close-out documents included; and establishing the warranty date effective May 23, 2017, through May 22, 2018.
